Tools for Online Lessons

I've been reluctant to write a blog post about teaching online lessons because I am far from being an expert on this matter. In the first lockdown I mainly set work on Hegarty Maths. I don't believe in reinventing the wheel. With good quality videos and tasks at my disposal, I was very happy to use them. This time round my school has changed its approach in order to improve the student experience and (hopefully) maximise engagement. So now I do some live lessons (we run these as Microsoft Teams events, which are recorded for students who need to watch at different times). We will shortly be introducing asynchronous practice lessons in maths too, for which I will mainly be using Hegarty Maths.

So compared to many other teachers I'm relatively new to live lessons. Thankfully the expertise of maths teachers on Twitter is already immense. Tweets about live lessons are constant and amazing, with teachers all over the world giving each other practical advice and inspiration. I thought it might be helpful to share some of that advice here for my readers who aren't on Twitter. I'm not featuring the well-known websites here - we are very lucky that there are absolutely loads for maths (Hegarty Maths, Dr Frost, Corbett Maths, MyMaths, Mathigon, MathsWatch, MathsPad, White Rose, Times Table Rockstars, Desmos and so on). Here I'm featuring tools and websites that might be less well-known. This should give you a starting point to investigate further if you are looking for a particular solution for your online maths lessons.

1. If you use Google Classroom...

I don't work in a Google school but if I did then I would make use of [@Philmaths314](#)'s free [Self Marking Google Sheets](#). As the name suggests, these are sheets that mark themselves. The site is very easy to use: choose a sheet, create your own copy and then assign to your pupils. When they input answers, they get an instant score. I featured this resource in [Gems 131](#).

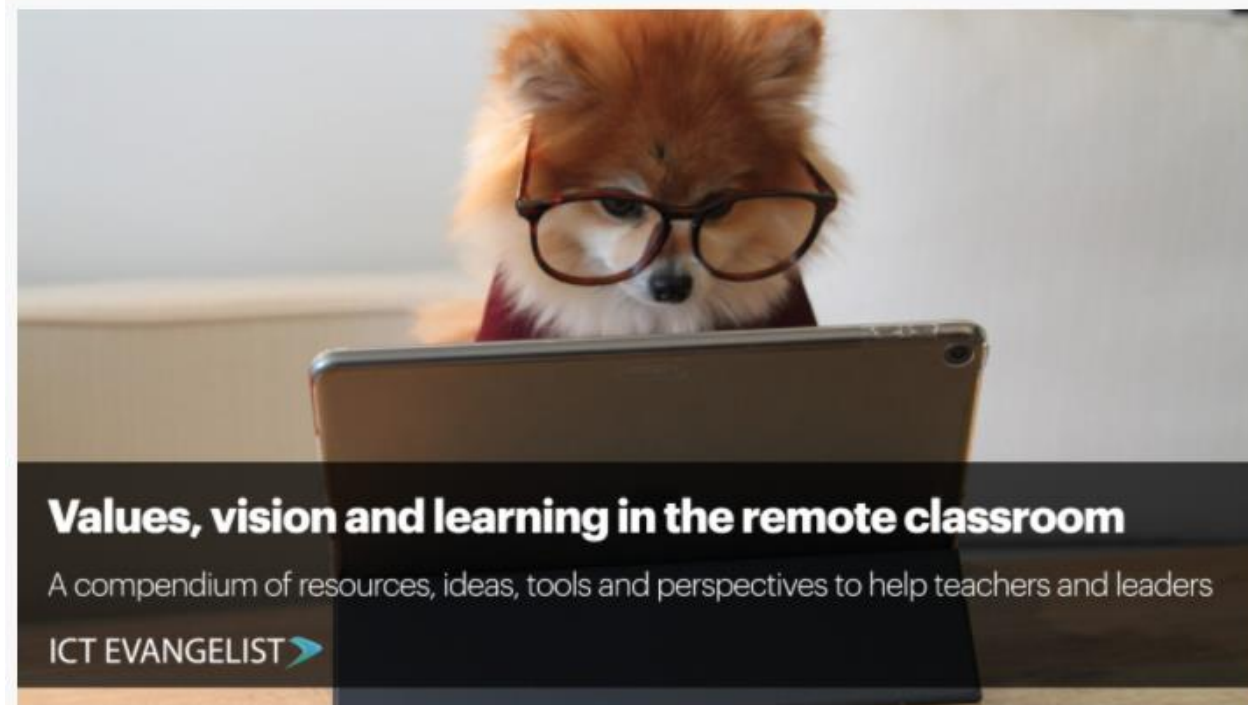


The sheets can be downloaded as spreadsheets too, so can also be used outside of Google Classroom.

Well, here we are again, back in lockdown and remote learning in full swing. As I look around the Twittersphere there are many strands to learning and teaching. On the one hand, you have Gavin Williamson and cronies asking for parents to tattle on schools not doing well. You have the initiative sparked by [David Mitchell asking for parents](#) to use that 'hotline' to share about schools doing well and Ofsted being inundated by parents saying [how great schools are doing](#).

You have the ideologies of the DfE being that Oak is the best model for online delivery which as [Bob Harrison](#) and many others attest, simply isn't learning. Alongside this, you have teachers and schools scrambling for ideas for different teaching and learning strategies with technology as this [curation from Tom Sherrington](#) shows. It shouldn't though be about lots of different new technologies though, which I'll come on to later.

In short – it's somewhat of a nightmare for educators. Sure, having had lockdown last year, we should be in a much better place than this. But we are not. My own experiences of home learning haven't been a bed of roses either, having spent time with my own son in Year 7 this week, in tears, trying his hardest to do what is asked of him but struggling to cope with the pressures.

Reasons for not providing live lessons

1. Siblings can't be online on one device at the same time (yes we've done our best to provide enough devices but they don't all have their own). We are committed to equitable experiences for all during lockdown and a live offer wouldn't align with that.
2. Some parents want live to allow pupils to check in with classmates. We have a 'Posts' page on Teams. It allows pupils to engage with each other in a safe way.
3. Assemblies allow pupils to continue to feel part of the community. A live lesson wouldn't necessarily provide that.
4. Learning is our focus. Work submitted on Teams is checked and pupils get individual feedback. We're not convinced a live lesson provides the opportunity for this level of feedback.
5. Even if a live lesson does provide this level of feedback, when would staff have the time? They are working hard to manage everything. Time out to teach live cuts down on time interacting with pupils individually.
6. Live lessons are exhausting. Workload is already far exceeding normal teaching. We must safeguard the wellbeing of our staff.

Giving Instructions

- Give the lesson/work a title - Label all documents/assignments/headings with the same title.
- When setting a task, divide it into stages (use a numbered list) and be specific in the exact resource/task that they should complete and how you want it done.
- Keep materials (resources), assignments, quizzes separate if possible, to keep things clear rather than putting them all into one assignment post. Using topic headings to organise them together with clear labelling.
- Provide all internet links – not just ‘Watch the Oak Academy lesson on Moses’ but...
‘Follow this link and complete all of the ‘Moses and the Exodus’ Oak Academy lesson’

- Be clear on WHAT should/should not be submitted to the teacher and HOW this should be done.....

Sustaining Motivation

Remove Barriers

Make the work you set as accessible as possible in a practical sense: fewer attachments, concise instructions, reduction of non-essential information.

Convey Purpose

Emphasise to students that engaging with lessons will help them to know and do more in the future. As a way of showing this, make connections with work they've done in the past.

Overcommunicate Expectations

Clearly define the parameters of acceptable behaviour. Explicitly convey what you expect your wards to do and achieve, and repeat yourself often.

Promote Desirable Norms

Regularly highlight examples of good work to help positively influence students who might ordinarily be tempted to slack-off a bit. Remember that most students have a strong 'herd mentality'.

Give Praise

Use established departmental and whole-school systems to convey meaningful praise. Reward both effort and attainment.
